### **Culture of Generosity**

Description: Is your congregation's approach to stewardship stuck in a rut? Are you living in a state of scarcity and longing for abundance? Learn how to form your Generosity Team, how to create an activities calendar for your church's funds ministry, how to prepare a narrative budget, and how to integrate all aspects of your church into the life of generosity.

Description: Does your church provide an opportunity for church members to leave their faith legacy to the church. Come learn the basics about how to set up an effective planned giving and wills emphasis program. Learn the policies you need in order to have endowments and legacy funds. Walk away with ideas for the simple ways you can begin to invite people to leave their faith legacy to the church.

### **Capital Campaigns**

Description: This workshop will help churches determine their readiness to launch a capital campaign. It will look at those elements that need to be in place for a campaign to reach its full potential. The workshop will also present an overview of the components of an active campaign from campaign launch to Dedication Sunday and throughout the pledging period.

He works with congregations to create a culture of generosity, offers seminars and workshops, develops gifts and fundraising plans for ministries, and provides coaching to finance, stewardship, and endowment committees. He is a member of First Presbyterian Church in Peachtree City where his wife, Rev. Morgan Hay, serves as the pastor. **John Elder Wray** is an independent Funds Development Consultant for the Presbyterian Foundation, Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), and Church Campaign Services. As a consultant for the Presbyterian Foundation, John works with small membership churches and churches with smaller dollar capital needs. Previously, John was the Coordinator for Church Financial Campaign Service (CFCS) of the PC(USA). John has provided direct campaign counsel to many churches and has been involved with church and presbytery feasibility studies, stewardship programs and capital campaigns as a part of CFCS, CCS and the Presbyterian Foundation since 1999.
