Beth-El Farmworker Ministry: Sharing the Fruit of the Spirit

Most of the seasonal crops in Florida have come to an end. Many in our community have already begun their trek northward to more fertile soils and the promise of a more bountiful season. They will return come fall, when the first killing frost kills off the last of the summer harvest in the north. Like all else in life, we at Beth-El follow the seasons.



One might assume that things are quieter during the summer months, but that couldn't be farther from the truth. Summertime is a buzz of activity. Mission teams from all over the country arrive to help support our community. Our hallways are filled with the sounds of children laughing and playing during our weeks of Vacation Bible School. Adults young and old arrive with carloads of back to school supplies, and the skies seem a little brighter with the smiles of children returning from Cedarkirk. A mission cannot sustain itself with one individual or church standing alone. It *does* take a village: called into communion to love, encourage, and support one another.

This year has been particularly difficult for our farmworking community. The hot fall and wet winter lessened the harvest. Beyond the fields, the political rancor of politicians has heightened anxiety regardless of legal status. Still the most fragile in our community are the children, many of whom will never experience summer camp or a new pair of shoes. This is why supporting children and young adults into pathways of transformation is so vital to Beth-El's mission.

- ◆ This summer Beth-El will send 42 children to Cedarkirk for a week of summer camp.
- ◆ We will collect back to school supplies to help 300 or more students return to school with the tools they need.
- ◆ We will lead Vacation Bible School to over 80 kids, and see the joy of young faces as they experience God's love through the love of others.
- ◆ This fall we will welcome 50 students stridently working to complete their GED or learn English as a second language, providing scholarships for those individuals as well as those wishing to pursue an advanced degree.

One scholarship recipient recently wrote: "I have the desire to study hard and work towards my goals no matter the obstacle, but without financial help it is hard to continue." Mayra is the recipient of the Anne Frank Humanitarian Award, and is part of the Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society at Hillsborough Community College. Her long term goal is to become a pediatrician. Beth-El's mission is to help young people like Mayra achieve their goals, even if at the moment that goal is nothing more than a new pair of shoes.

There is something very powerful when we take communion by intinction. We look into another's eyes taking the bread and hearing the words from centuries past: "This is Christ's body broken for you." We take the cup, initiating a new covenant bound in God's love. We are in communion with one another. Yes, it takes a village, called together as a community in Christ. Thank you for being our covenant partners to the mission of Beth-El Farmworker Ministry.
