I'm Bill Teng, Pastor of First Presbyterian Church in Arcadia. As you may already know, 2016 is the 25th anniversary of Peace River Presbytery and the presbytery Steering Committee has asked the Planning Team to plan a Festival of Worship & Thanksgiving to be held at 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, November 10, at the First Presbyterian Church in Bonita Springs.

As part of the worship, I've been charged to put together a combined choir which would include singers representing every one of our 37 congregations in the Presbytery.
