Misión Peniel – A Ministry to Farmworkers in Immokalee



There is a “RENEWAL” at Misión Peniel!

“The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases, his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.” Lamentations 3:22-23

Ever since moving into a new building on February 20th of this year, Misión Peniel has been in a process of a “mission renewal” as it settles into its new home at 208 Boston Avenue in Immokalee. The “RE’s” pretty much define the renewal taking place over the past few months! Staff and volunteers have been working non-stop to:

RE-model: The building acquired was previously used as a dance and gymnastics studio. It is *three times* the size of the previous mission space at the same monthly rental fee. Partial walls were built and painted to create an office area, gathering area, kitchen and pantry areas and clothing storage area. Additional lighting and outlets were installed. Remodeling work is nearly complete thanks to dedicated and talented volunteers and contracted workers.

RE-organize: All of the remodeled space is undergoing some major reorganization to serve the mission’s ministry more efficiently. The goal is to organize all donations into their specific space. This will allow us to have a clearer idea of what we have and what is needed at any given time.

RE-fresh: Since February, Pastor Miguel, Ruth and the Misión Peniel Team have been working with Divine Digital in Naples, to design a new logo, build a new website and create a new mission email address. RE-think:

Serving— Now that we have additional staff and a much larger space, we are beginning to “re-think” the opportunities for serving the mission we offer to individual volunteers and groups. We still rely on church groups to sign up for Friday meal serving and clothing distribution. We also want to begin inviting volunteers (group or individuals) to come on Wednesdays, from 10 a.m. - 1 pm, beginning May 3rd. We also encourage you to share YOUR mission ideas for serving the needs of the farmworker community in Immokalee.

Donation of Goods— Misión Peniel has learned over the years that there are certain donation items that are greatly needed and others that are never utilized. As a result, in the coming weeks and months it is our hope to communicate with donors what the mission really needs and what simply takes up valuable space. As the communication improves, an important re-thinking takes place about how we donate for mission purposes, our efficiency increases, and the real needs in Immokalee are met.

RE-new what it means to be partners in mission ... among our churches and with the farm worker community in Immokalee. As partners in mission, there is much that God has to show us through our Haitian and Hispanic brothers and sisters! Watch for announcements of local activities and events and consider participating!

Join farmworkers and their families for a lively demonstration at the newly-opened Orangetree Publix in Naples!



Last month, farmworkers embarked on a 12-city [Return to Human Rights Tour](#) visiting cities across the Southeast and Midwest to rally with allies of faith, students, and conscious consumers to promote the national Wendy's boycott and the longstanding struggle for farmworker justice. The grand finale took place in Tampa as nearly 300 allies from across Florida [marched from Publix to Wendy's](#) to call on both holdouts to join the CIW's award-winning Fair Food Program.

On March 23, as the CIW prepared to converge in [Wendy's](#) hometown of Columbus, OH for the tour's vibrant culmination, Publix inaugurated a new location in the CIW's own backyard on Immokalee Rd. in Naples. For almost eight years, the Florida-based supermarket chain has continuously refused to engage in dialogue with farmworkers about protecting their human rights and has rejected the Fair Food Program, a proven, worker-led solution to farmworker abuse in the U.S. agricultural industry.

Let us call on Publix to finally make a true commitment to supporting human rights for the farmworkers that make their profits possible, by joining the Fair Food Program! Join us and scores of our Southwest Florida allies for a spirited and peaceful demonstration at the newly-opened Orangetree Publix on Immokalee Rd. and Randall Blvd.
