BLESSING GRANTS

The Peace River Blessing Grants is a forward looking effort to use dedicated money to aid our congregations in developing new initiatives and reaching out into our communities in new and imaginative ways.

Last fall we were able to award the first \$25,000. We were blessed to receive a variety of proposals from churches of every size imaginable. It was fun to see the thought and creativity that went into each proposal. Some of these are complete and others are still a work in progress.

At an upcoming Presbytery meeting we will have a Lessons Learned time from those awarded grants. They will share what worked, what did not work, lessons they learned along the way, and inspire all of us to think outside the box and listen for the direction of the Spirit in each of our contexts.

This year, we switched to one award cycle a year. This meant we have more money to award, but it also meant that we need to be very thorough and careful in getting good information and documentation. We had fewer applications and we went back to almost all for additional clarification and information. The Task Force is still in the process of making award decisions to forward to the Steering Committee.

This round of applications is even richer in the diversity of approaches and creativity of thought. I am excited to announce, in the coming months, who has been awarded a grant and how that will be utilized.

We are hopeful that the corpus in the fund will soon reach at least one million dollars and grow beyond that. That will provide strong resources in the years ahead.

If you are interested in applying for a grant in 2019, the time to begin is now! Engage your session in the discussions and begin to give creative and imaginative thought into how you can better reach out into your community.

May God bless these grants and enable us to be a conduit of His blessings to the communities and congregations we serve.
