Weekly Presbytery Letter ~ July 18, 2018

Growing Into Our Cuban Partnership Between Matanzas and Peace River Presbyteries

In 1890, the first formal Presbyterian missionary organized the first Presbyterian church in Cuba. That spark began in Havana and spread quickly to include seven Presbyterian churches in Havana by 1904. Those churches were organized into a presbytery within the Synod of New Jersey. The Presbyterian church continued to expand and grow in many areas with backing from Presbyterian churches and denominational mission support in the United States. The Presbyterian churches in Cuba were known for their schools and medical clinics, both serving the local communities.

In 1961, shortly after Castro came to power, a triple whammy hit the Presbyterian churches on the island. The embargo severely curtailed support from the United States. Second, a “brain drain” occurred when many clergy and lay leaders escaped to the United States, leaving many churches without ordained ministers and leaders. The ability to educate up and coming clergy was also stunted. And third, the communist government seized the schools and medical clinics. Even though Castro did not close the churches, many had to close for the above-mentioned reasons. Up to 1990, the churches in the official atheist country held on with great difficulty. Church members could not be a member of the Communist party and participate in government. Also in this period, women stepped up and kept many of the churches afloat while men had to take government sanctioned jobs.

In the mid-1980s, PCUSA mission efforts were able to crack open some doors. The communist government began to allow partnerships between presbyteries of the two nations. By 1990, Castro told the nation that churches should go from being tolerated to being “respected”. Castro recognized that churches could be a help in the communities where they were located, taking some of the burden off the government.

Fast forward to February, 2018 ... Today we celebrate the journey that has led us to establish a formal partnership between the Matanzas and Peace River Presbyteries, and prepare for our first partnership trip to Cuba this fall!

From September 27-October 2, twenty-eight people, representing eight Peace River churches, will meet with church leaders and congregation members from the Matanzas Presbytery to continue to build relationships and explore mutual ministry opportunities. Peace River participants will visit local congregations to learn about their ministries and explore further partnership opportunities. Churches that will be represented include:

Covenant (Ft. Myers), Cypress Lake (Ft. Myers), Faith (Cape Coral), First (Naples), First (Sarasota), Hope United (Estero), Northminster (Sarasota) and Vanderbilt (Naples).

We are also exploring partnering with the Matanzas Evangelical Theological Seminary, in supporting seminary students studying for the ministry, in Matanzas Presbytery. One of our churches working in this area is First (Bonita).

As per our Presbytery’s partnership agreement, we hope to bring formal recommendations for church to church partnerships for presbytery approval at the November presbytery meeting. We are excited for the ways in which God is leading us forward! Your support through prayers and other resources for our mutual journey into partnership is greatly appreciated!
