**Candidate Phase

To provide for the full preparation of persons to serve the church as ministers of the Word and Sacrament. This shall be accomplished through the guidance and evaluation of candidates, using learning contacts within the context of supportive relationships. (See G-14.0305 for details.)

CANDIDATE PHASE:

SEARCH PROCESS BEGINS

Search process begins. Once call is issued, Candidate is examined by new Presbytery and approved for ordination. Ordination can be done in home Presbytery, or in Presbytery where call is located.

Candidate for at least one year
Pass all five national ordination exams
(Bible Content, Polity, Worship, Theology,
Scripture Exegesis w/sermon outline)
Meet Book of Order requirements (G-14.0450)

Throughout Candidate Phase

Throughout Candidate Phase annual consultations allow for review of process and progress.

READY FOR A CALL

When all the above requirements have been met, and if the CPM discerns the call to Ministry of Word and Sacrament has come to fruition, the candidate is given permission to circulate PIF, thus indicating the person is ready to receive a call. This is reported to Presbytery. (G-14.0450) (It is recommended that the liaison read the PIF before it is circulated.)
