

Dependent Care Reimbursement Policy for Commissioners Attending Peace River Presbytery Meetings

Peace River Presbytery identifies a dependent care plan for our presbytery meetings as a key priority in our common Christian commitment to equipping our families and members.

Presbytery commissioners (teaching and ruling elders, certified Christian educators, and other voting attendees) may be reimbursed up to \$200 per meeting per commissioner (not per child or adult) to utilize their typical care services for dependent adults and children under their care while serving the larger church at presbytery meetings.

A dependent is defined as a child under the age of 18 or an adult dependent requiring care and is the responsibility of the commissioner. Commissioners are required to indicate ahead of the meeting that they would like to request reimbursement and are required to submit receipts (or, alternatively, proof of services) for care to the presbytery for reimbursement.

This policy adopted October 21, 2023, and commenced January 1, 2024
