Margaret Day Memorial Fund
Guidelines

PURPOSE: The "Margaret Day Memorial Fund" was named for the Southwest Florida Presbyterian president who served 1977-79. It is funded by offerings and special gifts from Presbyterian Women in PRP churches.

The purpose of the "Margaret Day Fund" is to:

- Honor the memory and work of Margaret Day;
- Provide financial support to Presbyterian women in Peace River Presbytery to attend PW educational, fellowship and spiritual enrichment opportunities (PW retreats, seminars, conferences, etc.); and
- Provide ongoing leadership and support to PRP Presbyterian Women.

PROCEDURE: Presbyterian Women interested in requesting financial support should complete the "Application for Financial Support" and submit with a copy of the event registration to the PW Treasurer, at least two months prior to the event.

PW Treasurer will review to ensure eligibility of candidate and event - then submit endorsement to the PW Moderator for presentation and approval by PW Coordinating Team.

Amount requested should not exceed 50% of the total event cost for a single event. Amount granted will be determined by the PRP PW CT, based on funds available at the time of request.

If the applicant is unable to attend the event, the total amount of funds received from the EWSF must be returned to the PW Treasurer.
